Sip Sip Hooray: Three Exciting Updates

- Resilient Communities Initiative: we distributed \$28,000 in seed funds to support farmer-led and designed income diversification projects in Costa Rica. In addition, the 2023 cohort received a series of masterclasses in collaboration with a variety of subject matter experts. These includes a finance workshop with VP of Western Union LATAM, Erick Van der Laat, and a personal branding workshop with Magma Comunicación.
- Market Readiness Initiative: we hosted our first Harvest Town Hall in January, inviting buyers of specialty coffee from around the world. We are excited to welcome Flor Coghi to the Bean Voyage team to co-lead the Market Readiness Initiative. As part of her role, Flor has helped us streamline the overall supply chain and make it more effective for us to communicate with both farmers and buyers.
- Women-Powered Coffee Summit: the 3rd edition of Women-Powered Coffee Summit is coming to Mexico and we're excited to announce the dates! The summit will take place from October 2-4, 2024 at the beautiful Museo del Cafe, in Cordoba, Veracruz. We are thrilled to bring together 250 participants for this edition, with a focus on creating a space and inclusive space that centers the experiences, stories, and work of smallholder women coffee farmers.
